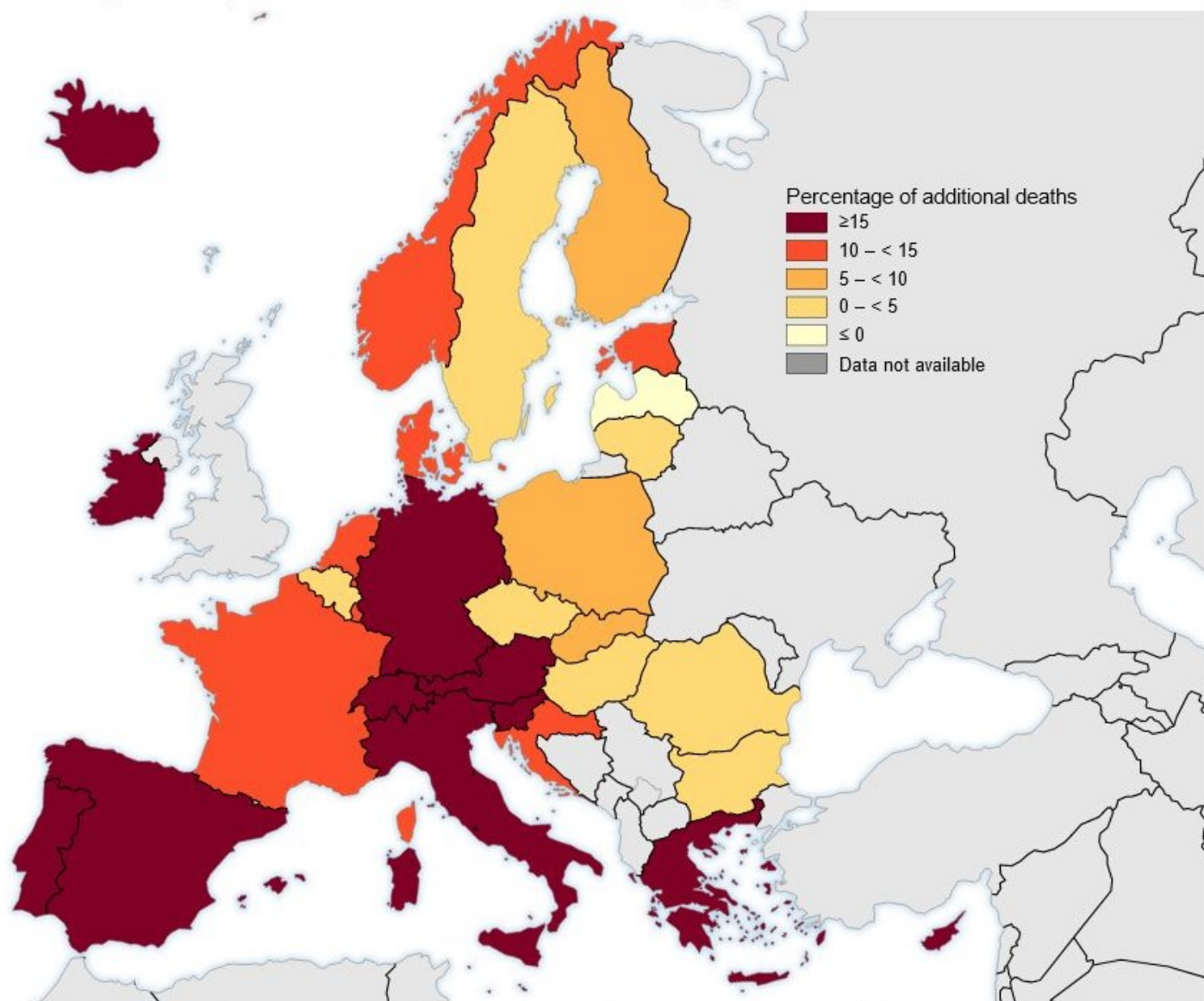


Excess Mortality in July 2022

Data for 2022 are provisional.

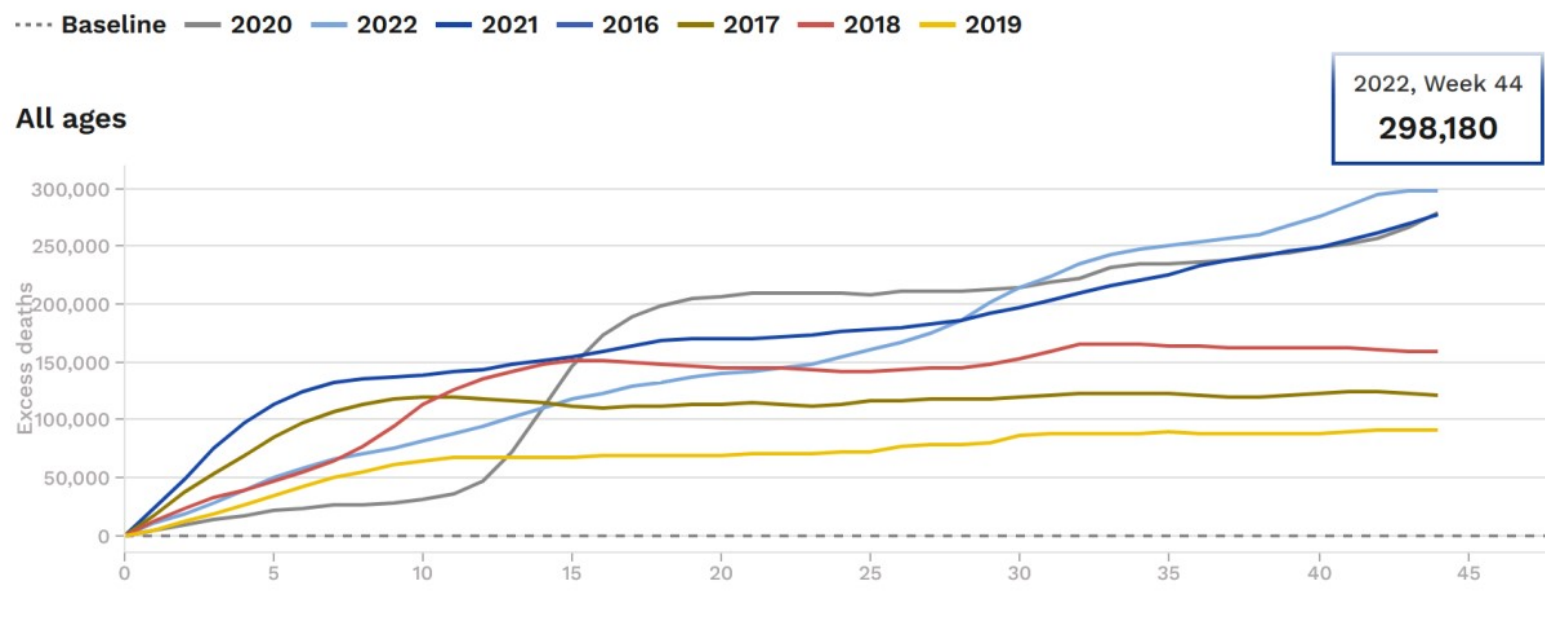
